Why the change: Historically, the Learning Services Home & School Association (LSHSA) has served critical roles of support, education and enrichment for Ridgewood's special education community. In addition, the LSHSA has served as Ridgewood's special education parent advisory group (SEPAG)--a state-mandated, district-level, parent-driven group charged with providing input to the local school district on system-level challenges in special education and related services. In an effort to emphasize our expanded focus on this central function (more news to come on our efforts!), we are renaming our organization accordingly.

What this means: Functionally, we will continue to serve families in the same ways we always have: through informal guidance, information meetings, social events, enrichment through scholarships, etc. Most significantly, we will be expanding and improving our capacity to gather parent feedback and to work collaboratively with administrators to put that input into action.




